The new Haven Home of Kalipay was blessed on March 07, 2012. The two-story home has complete facilities that can accommodate at least 40 children.

It also has separate bedrooms for boys, girls and toddlers with bathrooms, a library-classroom for some of the children who are home schooled, a timeout room for those suffering from trauma who become violent, a kitchen, a living room, an office for social workers, a clinic, a room for kitchen staff and two rooms for volunteers who help take care of the children.

The picture below was with the Philippine Ambassador to Spain, Mr. Carlos Salinas. He too helped Kalipay in so many ways.


